Aware of the richness and fragility of our environment, we place sustainability at the heart of our activity.

We have taken steps to obtain the **Green Key eco-label**, an international recognition that distinguishes tourist establishments committed to a demanding and proactive environmental management.

Each initiative that we set up aims to preserve the domain natural balance, to promote the well-being of our customers and our employees, and to make Château Gassies part of a **sustainable dynamic that respects its territory**.

Our responsible economic commitments

We favour **short supply chains** and **local partners**: wedding service providers, bakers, wine producers, etc. We also promote local hotels and restaurants to our customers.



Repairs are preferred over new purchases. We give furniture a **second life** by purchasing it at auction and restoring it. Unused furniture is donated to our staff and local charities.



Creation of a **gastronomic discovery activity** in partnership with local producers and a **beehive project**.

Our environmental commitments



14 hectares under "zero phyto" management, we promote a **sustainable ecosystem**: closed circuit, green waste valuation, organic orchard and vegetable garden, compost and rainwater reuse.



An **eco-responsible approach**: selective sorting, responsible in-house laundry management, eco-labelled cleaning products and refillable dispensers in the bathroom. A bicycle room is available for guests' use.



Optimizing energy consumption with **sustainable solutions**: solar-powered Velux windows, sensor-controlled lighting, and outdoor solar bollards. Room heating is automatically regulated, and rechargeable batteries are used for remote controls.
